Do you have a plan?

Complete a disaster plan before the chaos of an approaching hurricane to be sure you have time to do it right. Do home improvements during the cooler days of the year. Pack your Emergency Survival Kits before June 1 to be sure you have what you need. Organize important papers so you can grab them quickly.

To help with your planning, PinellasCounty.org/emergency/prepareahead.htm provides a variety of checklists from Important Documents to Pets to make sure that you don't forget any key parts to your survival plan.

Do you know your zone?

PinellasCounty.org/emergency/knowyourzone.htm has tools to help you to find out what your zone is. There are also interactive maps that show you the storm surge impact on specific areas.

Stay connected!

If you'd like to receive information directly through your email or by phone call or text message, you can sign up for *Alert Pinellas*. An automated system will call land lines and cell phones at the same time an email and text message will go out, so you could receive four notifications to alert you to local emergencies. 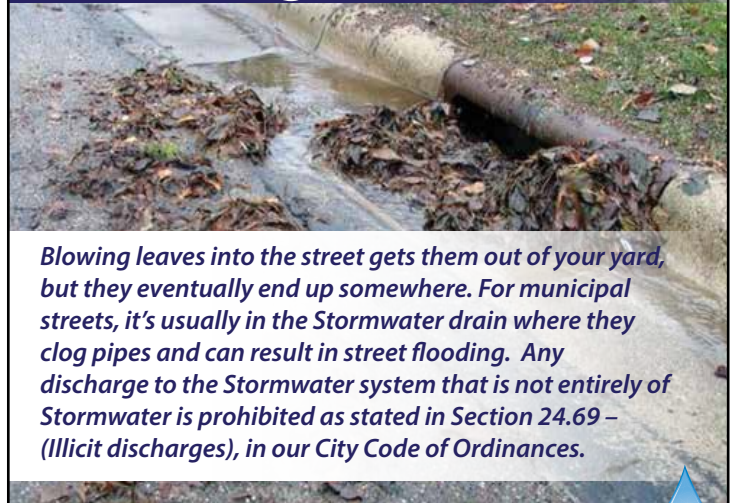

The City of Safety Harbor is a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program/Community Rating System (NFIP/CRS). We offer FEMA flood map determinations on property located in the city. Don't Clog Storm Drains



Blowing leaves into the street gets them out of your yard, but they eventually end up somewhere. For municipal streets, it's usually in the Stormwater drain where they clog pipes and can result in street flooding. Any discharge to the Stormwater system that is not entirely of Stormwater is prohibited as stated in Section 24.69 – (Illicit discharges), in our City Code of Ordinances.

Please, only rain down the drain.
