

## Permit Procedures

- A building permit is required for all temporary banners.
- **Requirements for submittal:**
  - ❖ Building permit application.
  - ❖ Print out or drawing of what the sign will look like can't exceed 8' x 4'
- **Review:** Plans are not reviewed, this is an over the counter permit **AND ONLY GOOD FOR 14 DAYS WITHIN A THREE-MONTH PERIOD** – write on the permit the dates (example: 1/1/17 -1/15/17).

### 212.04 Grand openings, new business, or promotional signs.

(A) A temporary sign announcing a grand opening, new business, special or promotion shall be allowed subject to obtaining a permit in accordance with the following restrictions:

- (1) The sign is on site;
- (2) The sign, including banners, does not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet in aggregate area;
- (3) A minimum setback of five (5) feet from all property lines is required;
- (4) The maximum height shall be 8 feet;
- (5) The sign shall not be illuminated;
- (6) The sign shall not be erected more than a total of fourteen (14) days within a three-month period;
- (7) Flags shall not be subject to the maximum sign area;
- (8) Balloons, inflatable objects, portable signs and pennants shall not be permitted.

- **At the time of Issuance**, there will be no permit fee.
- **Inspections:** No inspection needed.
- **The permit may be obtained by the following:**
  - ◆ BUSINESS OWNER
