




### COMMUNITY RATING SYSTEM

In the spring of 2019, the city's Community Rating System was verified by the NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM, resulting in the approval of the CRS rating for another 5 YEARS.

Participation in this program results in lower flood insurance premium rates for policy holders.





