REGISTRATION

Program Registrations

Participants are required to complete an Activity Waiver. Waivers for participants under 18 must be completed by the parent or legal guardian.

Registration Methods

For the convenience of your REAL Fun experience, the City of Safety Harbor offers online registrations via: SafetyHarborRecreation.com. In person registrations are available at the Community Center, Rigsby Center, Museum and Cultural Center, and Folly Farmhouse.

Payments and Pricing

Payments are due in full at time of registration. Payment options: Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express, Cash, Check or Money Order(made out to City of Safety Harbor), and Gift Cards. Payment plans are available by contacting a manager. No cash accepted at the Folly Farmhouse.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

Cancellations must be made at least 8 days prior to the start of a camp, program, or trip. No refunds will be processed after a program has already begun. Event tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. If a program is cancelled by the Recreation Department, a FULL refund will be issued. Refunds are issued as a household credit. If a refund check is desired, it must be put in writing to REALRefunds@cityofsafetyharbor.com.

Refund checks take two weeks for processing and are only mailed to the account holder and address listed on the account. Refund policies for specific programs and emergencies supersede the General Refund Policy.

Reservations: Cancellations for indoor facilities, gazebos, and the barn must be made at least 14 days in advance for a full refund minus a \$50 cancellation fee. Cancellations for shelters must be made 7 days in advance for a full refund, minus \$10 cancellation fee. No reservation refunds will be issued due to weather except for field reservations.

Weather Policy

If inclement weather is forecasted, outdoor activities may be canceled for the safety of instructors and participants. Instructor/staff will make every effort to contact participants and either prorate the program or provide a makeup date. Call (727) 724-1560 for updates.

Priority Registrations

Some programs deemed "High Demand" programs will institute a Resident Registration timeframe to give top priority to our Safety Harbor residents. These programs are noted in the REAL program guide or the dates are noted on the online registration.

Waiting Lists

Waiting lists will be formed and maintained after the program limit has been reached. As spots in the program become available, persons on the list will be contacted in order and offered the opportunity to register in the program.

Program Cancellations: Minimums/Maximums


