

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAFETY HARBOR, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 BY INCREASING REVENUE AND APPROPRIATING EXPENDITURES AND FUND RESERVE WITHIN THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT PROJECTS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission at any time within a fiscal year or within 60 days following the end of the fiscal year, may amend the budget for that year by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, having observed all appropriate procedures required by Florida Statutes, the City Commission deems it necessary, proper, and in the best interest of the public to amend said budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAFETY HARBOR, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED, that:**

**SECTION 1.** The budget for the 2022-2023 fiscal year is hereby amended as incorporated herein and the amount stated as proposed revenue and expenditure shall be available for appropriation for the line items and purpose named below:

#### SUMMARY

Two Fire Department agenda items, scheduled on the consent agenda this evening, are included in this budget amendment.

On October 3<sup>rd</sup>, City Commission approved an agreement with the Florida Department of Financial Services to purchase equipment through the Florida Firefighter Cancer Decontamination Equipment Grant Program. The budget amendment includes the grant revenue, purchase of equipment, and a reduction of fund reserve as required match to purchase the equipment.

The Fire Department has obtained a quote and requested approval to award the contract for restroom renovations at Fire Station 53 in the amount of \$62,640. Of this total amount, \$57,610 is included in the FY 2023 adopted budget. The budget amendment reflects a \$5,030 increase for unknown contingencies.
