

## Cancellations

To cancel a trip you must contact the Rigsby Center at **(727)724-1545**.

Cancel **48 hours** prior your trip to receive a full refund. \*Unless tickets have been already purchased

- ♦ Be aware that you will not be receiving a refund if you cancel within 48 hours of your trip
