

Cancellations

To cancel a trip you must contact the Rigsby Center at **(727)724-1545**.

Cancel **48 hours** prior your trip to receive a full refund. *Unless tickets have been already purchased

- ◆ Be aware that you will not be receiving a refund if you cancel within 48 hours of your trip
- ◆ Cancellations/Refunds due to special circumstances will be made on a case-by-case basis
- ◆ Trips that require advance ticket purchases have a different refund policy. We do our best to give you a cancellation date; however, once we purchase tickets they are non-refundable
- ◆ If we can fill your spot with another person, such as the waitlist, we will issue a refund within the 48 hours
