### **1. Marshall Street Park (500 Marshall St)**

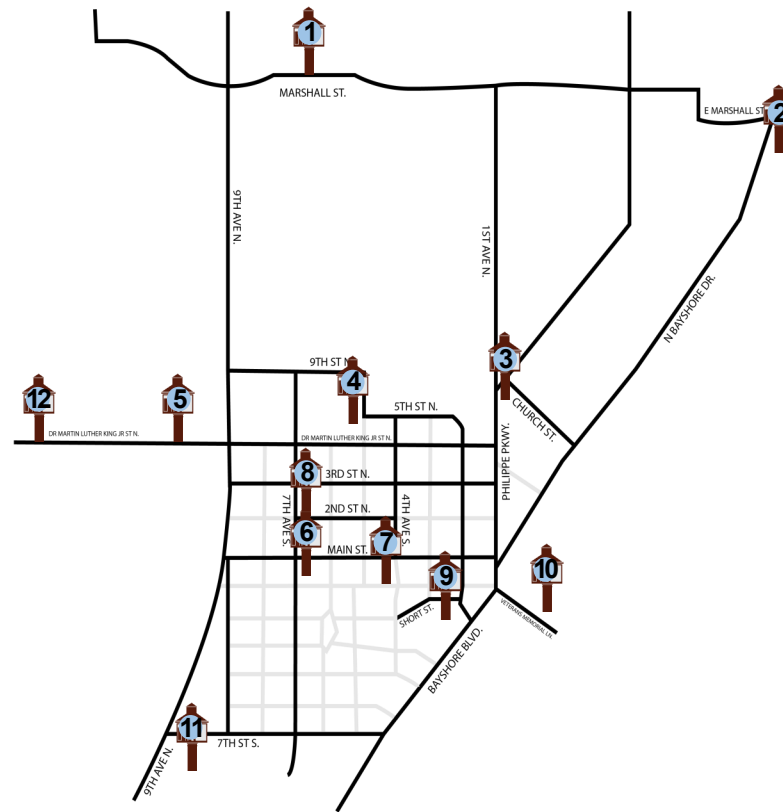
This Little Free Library was built by Jim Taylor, finished by Bill Bauer and painted by artist Mark Spencer. *LFL #18932*

### **2. South Entrance to Philippe Park (2113 N. Bayshore Blvd)**

Designed and built by Bob Boyd. Sponsored by Leveline Construction. Visit this location at the south entrance to Philippe Park. *LFL #21160*

### **3. Mullet Creek Park (536 Philippe Pkwy)**

Painted by Judith Overcash, donated by the Friends of the Library. Visit this location inside of Mullet Creek Park. *LFL #18532*



### **4. Safety Harbor Elementary (535 5th Ave N)**

### **5. Mattie Williams Neighborhood Family Center (1001 Dr. MLK Jr. St N.)**

### **7. John Wilson Park Gazebo (401 Main St.)**

Created by Michael Willie of Safety Harbor. Dedicated to Emily and Eli Meyerhoff and the Community of Safety Harbor *LFL #15760*

### **8. Rigsby Center (605 2nd St. N.)**

Built by Chuck Lynde and painted by artist Melissa Bourke featuring an underwater theme. *LFL #24599*

### **9. Safety Harbor Museum and Cultural Center (329 Bayshore Blvd S.)**

The only “pre-fab” Little Free Library in Safety Harbor. Visit this location right in front of the Museum. *LFL #13381*

### **10. Marina Park (110 Veterans Memorial Ln.)**

Sponsored by the Safety Harbor Garden Club, built by Kenny Buckman, designed by artist Cheryl Murray. *LFL #19706*

### **11. City Park (940 7th St. S.)**

Built by the upper EL students at Safety Harbor Montessori with assistance from Dr. Bob Redpath. Dedicated to all students in Safety Harbor. *LFL #16925*

### **12. Folly Farm Nature Preserve (1562 Dr. MLK St. N.)**
